Our Justice works to ensure that all people and communities have the power and resources to make sexual and reproductive health decisions with self-determination and dignity.

Our History

In 1967 abortion was illegal in the Midwest, single-parenthood was taboo, and adoption sent women and girls “away.” A small group of doctors, clergy, and community members came together to provide support to the people who were calling upon them for help. Our Justice was founded to be a place where individuals, families, and communities were treated with respect and dignity.

Abortion Support

People seeking abortion care can experience a multitude of barriers. Our Justice’s Abortion Assistance Fund provides financial assistance to people who would like to have an abortion but are unable to afford it. We are also working on launching a program that will connect people traveling long distances to access abortion care with volunteer hosts to remove the barrier of lodging from accessing abortion care.

Emerge

Emerge is a secular (non-religious) discussion and support group for anyone who has had an abortion. Emerge was created to fill the gap in after-abortion care by providing non-judgmental, emotional support for anyone who needs it.

Advocacy

Advocating for Reproductive Justice is integral for ending reproductive oppression. We work to educate our policymakers about the barriers people and families face in accessing reproductive health care and raising children, and how those barriers are a direct result of systemic forms of oppression.

Information on Sexual and Reproductive Health

We support your right to a pleasurable, healthy sexual experience. Our sexual and reproductive health resources provide guidance on how to have intimate conversations with your family or partners about sex, as well as information on Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs), pregnancy options, contraception, and more.
